Connecticut Farms Elementary School (Behavioral Disabilities)

- 1. The students IEPs will be reflective of the program placements. Their goals and objectives will be addressed in a less restrictive environment with proper supports and related services by providing the establishment of a self contained, Behavioral Disabilities program in Connecticut Farms Elementary School. Therefore, there are no unmet student needs.
- a. The age range is as follows: students aged 7.0-11.0 years of age. The class will have a maxminum of 12 students.
