### RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Township of Union Board of Education has a need to purchase new intercom and PA components to replace the obsolete system that is currently in place; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Union Board of Education approved a budget expenditure of \$58,960.46 in their 2012-2013 school budget to improve infrastructure and purchase new communication components in Union High School; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Union Administrative staff researched several intercom and PA systems and concluded that the best fit (price and product) for Union High School is the Rauland-Borg PA/intercom system will provide intercom and public address capabilities in Union High School and all other necessary components required to operate said system, at a total price of \$58,960.46; and

WHEREAS, the reseller of the Rauland-Borg system is a member of Pennsylvania Education Purchasing Program for Microcomputers (PEPPM), a national technology cooperative purchasing group from Pennsylvania, operated by the CSIU (Central Susquehanna Intermediary Unit), and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey approved P.L. 2011, Chapter 139 in November 2011, which allows New Jersey public entities, including local school districts to participate in National Cooperative Purchasing Agreements, and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs issued Local Finance Notice 2012-10 in May 2012 providing guidance for public entities in New Jersey on using National Cooperative Contracts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township of Union Board of Education has reviewed the requirements of P.L. 2011, Chapter 139 and LFN 2012-10 regarding the awarding of public contracts to a national cooperative purchasing agency and has met the requirements as follows:

 The Qualified Purchase Agent for the Township of Union Board of Education has collected all applicable documents required including the New Jersey Business Registration Certificate, Statement of Corporate Ownership, Affirmative Action compliance, political disclosure statement and a non-collusion affidavit.

- The Qualified Purchasing Agent for the Township of Union Board of Education has determined by written analysis that compared to applicable state contract pricing available, the WHRHS will save tax dollars by using the national cooperative contract versus the New Jersey state contract.
- The Township of Union Board of Education placed a legal advertisement in the Star Ledger and Union County Local Source, providing notification of the award of a contract using a national cooperative bid.

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Township of Union Board of Education hereby awards the PA/intercom system improvements to Alarm and Communications Technologies, Inc., 25 Ross Street, Wharton, New Jersey for the aforementioned PA/intercom system and all other necessary components required to operate Rauland-Borg PA/ intercom system, at a total price of \$58,960.46 based on their proposal dated August 2, 2012, and in compliance with the requirements of the national cooperative purchasing consortium, PEPPM.
