**CHAPTER 226 AGREEMENT
2012-2013
NONPUBLIC SCHOOL NURSING SERVICES**

THIS AGREEMENT made this first day of July 2012, between the Union County Educational Services Commission, having its principal office at 45 Cardinal Drive, in the Town of Westfield, County of Union, and State of New Jersey, hereinafter referred to as **U.C.E.S.C.**, and the _____ Board of Education having its principal office at _____, _____, New Jersey _____, County of Union, and State of New Jersey, hereinafter referred to as the **Public School District**.

WHEREAS, the U.C.E.S.C. by authority of its Board of Directors, acting on approval of the State Board of Education, is capable of providing auxiliary services to eligible students attending nonpublic schools; and

WHEREAS, the U.C.E.S.C. services are in accordance with Chapter 226, Laws of 1991, and the Rules and Regulations governing nursing services to nonpublic schools; and,

WHEREAS, the Public School District is under an obligation to provide said services to all eligible nonpublic schools within its district to assure equal access to specified nursing services; and

WHEREAS, the Public School District has by Resolution of its Board agreed to contract with the U.C.E.S.C. to provide said services pursuant to said legislation,

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- I. The terms and conditions of this Agreement shall be in effect from July 1, 2012 through and including June 30, 2013.
- II. The U.C.E.S.C. will provide agreed upon services from the following options within the limitation of funds:
 - A. Nursing services for eligible pupils who are enrolled full-time in the nonpublic school. The services shall include:
 1. assistance with medical examinations including dental screening;
 2. conducting screening of hearing examinations;
 3. the maintenance of student health records and notification of local or county health officials of any student who has not been properly immunized; and
 4. conducting examinations of pupils between the ages of 10 and 18 for the condition known as scoliosis.

- B. Adopt written policies and procedures to provide emergency care, comparable to that which is available to the public school pupil of the district wherein they are located through community emergency response teams. The schools would secure such emergency care and be reimbursed by the Commission for costs incurred within the limitations.

- III. The Commission shall contact the nonpublic schools within the district and determine the services they will require within the parameters of the law and limitations of funds.

- IV. The term of this Agreement shall be in effect from September 1, 2012 until June 30, 2013.

- V. The Board agrees to pay the Commission the amount of the Chapter 226 Nonpublic School Nursing funding agreed upon in support of the Nonpublic School Nursing Services plus a 6% administrative fee. Based on services rendered, the Commission will provide a monthly invoice beginning on October 1 for September, etc. and ending on June 30 of the current school year. The district will remit payment monthly to the Commission. No other funding is due the Commission in order to operate this program.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Board of Directors of the Union County Educational Services Commission and the _____ Board of Education, have by Resolution directed their respective Presidents and Secretaries to set their signatures and affix their seals. A certified copy of the Public School Resolution is annexed hereto.

RESOLUTION
NONPUBLIC SCHOOL NURSING SERVICES
PL 1991, CHAPTER 226**

WHEREAS, P.L. 1991, Chapter 226, requires that each Board of Education of a district in which a nonpublic school is located shall provide certain nursing services to those students who are enrolled full time in the nonpublic school; and

WHEREAS, the Union County Educational Services Commission has agreed to provide the required nursing services for local public school districts for the purpose of efficient delivery of services and greater cost effectiveness through cooperation and centralized administration;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that the _____ Board of Education enter into an agreement with the Union County Educational Services Commission whereby the Commission will implement the law and administer the nonpublic school nursing services program for those full time students enrolled in the nonpublic school(s) located within the _____ Board of Education for the 2012-2013 school year, in accordance with applicable law; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that the Board will remit the entire entitlement to the Commission to be billed monthly starting on October 1, 2012 and ending on July 1, 2013. The Commission will retain six percent (6%), of the entitlement as an administrative fee received by the _____ Board of Education as State aid, per pupil, pursuant to said enactment.
