

Honors and AP Criteria

APPLICATION:

To apply for the Honors/AP program, students must first complete an application, containing the following information:

- Name
- Grade
- Course applying for
- Course currently taking
- Current Teacher name
- Parent signature

CRITERIA:

Students must meet the criteria below:

1. Previous Department Course Grades
 - a. Honors to Honors/AP – Must have maintained a B or better in subject area
*in science, students must maintain a B or better in both math and science
 - b. Regular to Honors/AP – Must have maintained an A or better in subject area
*in science, students must maintain an A or better in both math and science
 - c. May not have failed any departmental courses

In addition to Criteria #1, students must meet or exceed 2 of the 3 of the following criteria:

2. Teacher Recommendation
 - a. Based on Departmental Procedures
 - b. Inputted into Genesis
3. CEMPA for Marking Period 1 AND Marking Period 2 in the course must be a "B" or better
 - b. No failing exam grades in any subject
4. Overall cumulative GPA must be 2.75 or greater.

Please Note:

Departments may require additional submissions and/or criteria which may include but not be limited to writing samples and/or assessments.

Appeal Process:

All students have the right to apply and request acceptance into an Honors/AP course. Students must obtain a standard appeals form online. The form can be downloaded and emailed to the department supervisor. All supervisors' contact information is on the district website. A hard copy of the appeals forms can also be picked up in guidance or downloaded below.
