

Teachers won grants totaling \$13824.15. Because of careful purchasing by myself, the total cost of the grants was \$11569.47, a saving of \$2254.68. Michael Atzbi received another grant that ended up saving us an additional \$516.37. The \$1000 we are scheduled to receive from an Investors Savings Bank will bring our cost down to \$2748.74 for the Orff & Tubano Sets.
