Please find this letter as Jersey Behavioral Care, LLC proposal to Union county, Board of Education, 2019-2020 school years.

Jersey Behavioral Care, LLC is a behavioral health clinic located in Union Township, NJ. We offer a full range of behavioral health services. Our licensed clinicians perform Comprehensive Mental Health Assessments as well as individual, group, family and couples therapy. Our medical staff provided Psychiatric Evaluations and medication management. We are able to children, as well as adolescents, adults and the geriatrics with a wide range of behavioral health issues, including, but not limited to anxiety, depressions, bipolar disorder, personality disorders, attention deficit disorder (ADHD), OCD, ODD, school refusal, protracted grief, substance use disorders, impulse control disorders, anger management and relationship issues.

Jersey Behavioral Care accepts Medicaid as well as numerous other medical insurances. For patients without insurance we do have a self-pay option.

In response to the needs of the Union Township Board of Education, Jersey Behavioral Care is willing and able to complete Comprehensive Mental Health Assessments for students referred due to suicidal ideation or attempt. Our licensed mental health professionals would be able to assess the client's mental status and make an adequate risk assessment to determine the student's ability to return to school as well as providing recommendations for treatment level of care as indicated. We are also able to complete Urine Drug Screens as indicated.

Where appropriate, Jersey Behavioral Care would bill the student's health insurance for payment. The student (or the school district) would be responsible for any co-pays, co-insurances or unmet deductibles. In cases where there is no insurance, or the student and their family opt not to use their health insurance our fee structure is as follows:

Comprehensive Mental Health Assessment, completed by a licensed clinician-\$120.

Psychotherapy, with a licensed clinician-\$80 per session (45-50 minute session)

Psychiatric Intake, completed by MD or Advanced Practice Nurse-\$180

Medication Management/Psychiatric Follow-up- \$120

Please be advised the above fees are good for 2019-2020 school years.

Payment is expected at the time of service, however if the school district is paying for the service, a letter of guarantee of payment would be need at the time of service and a bill would be sent to the appropriate district office.

Jersey Behavioral Care is generally able to schedule appointments within 24-48 hours of initial phone call, however this may be able to be expedited in certain situations.

Jersey Behavioral Care is located right in the heart of Union Township at 1945 Morris Ave, Suite 7 and is committed to servicing the community. Providing this service to the Union Township Board of Education is a way of doing this.

In consideration of the mutual promises, covenants, and agreements contained in the Contract parties agree as follows:

In accordance with the New Jersey "Pass the Trash" law, N.J.S.A. 18A:6-7.6 to 7.13 (hereinafter "Law"), which became effective June 1, 2018, JBC, LLC reby acknowledges its obligations under the Law and certifies that it is in compliance with the Law and all obligations required therein. The JBC LLC agrees to continue to comply with all requirements of the Law during the term of the Contract.

Furthermore, the [COMPANY] shall indemnify, defend, and hold, the Board and its respective officers, employees, servants, agents, assigns and affiliates ("Indemnified Parties"), harmless from and against, any and all suits, actions, liabilities, losses, claims, damages, and expenses including, without limitation, costs of investigation and defense (including costs of private investigation and surveillance), costs for medical treatment, expert witness fees, legal fees (e.g., fees of attorneys, paralegals and other legal professionals for the defense of the underlying suits, etc.), expenses and diminution of value, whether or not involving a third party claim, arising out of or in any manner connected with the Company's compliance with, or lack thereof, its obligations under the Law, N.J.S.A. 18A:6-7.6 to 7.13, to be provided for the Indemnified Parties, including, but not limited to, services performed under this Agreement and Addendum, or any such other work performed for the Indemnified Parties, in any way related to the acts or omissions of the Company, its agents, servants, employees, Subcontractors, subconsultants, anyone directly or indirectly employed by them or anyone for whose acts or omissions they may be legally liable ("Covered Parties") to the extent that such suits, actions, liabilities, losses, claims, damages and expenses are caused by the Covered Parties. If in a given case a court rules that the Company is not negligent and/or did not breach its statutory duty, then the Company no longer has an obligation to defend and indemnify the Board in such case.
