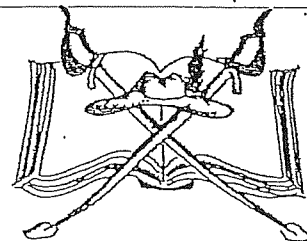

Monthly Snack Sale Fundraiser

Purpose: To provide a steady, ongoing source of income for the cheer program from December to June. All proceeds from each month's sale will go directly to the cheer program to support ongoing and future expenses such as new uniforms (program currently does not have enough uniforms to support all sizes for all athletes), game day bows, team warm ups and team shirts. We will also use the funds to support team bonding activities, equipment and school spirit items for future seasons (i.e. signs, tumbling and stunting mats)

How it works:

- Beginning in December and continuing through June, the BMS cheer program will host a snack sale on the first Friday of each month.
- The sale will take place right outside the school by the open field (weather permitting, i.e. over 40 degrees or no precipitation), making it convenient for students and families.
- Items to be sold:
 1. Assorted candy
 2. Bottled water
 3. Gatorade
- Prices will be set to be affordable while still allowing for a meaningful profit
 1. Candy will be priced between \$2-\$4
 2. Bottled water will be priced at \$1-\$2
 3. Gatorade will be priced at \$2-\$4
- Cheerleaders may assist with setup, clean up, and serving customers (if allowed by school policy)
