

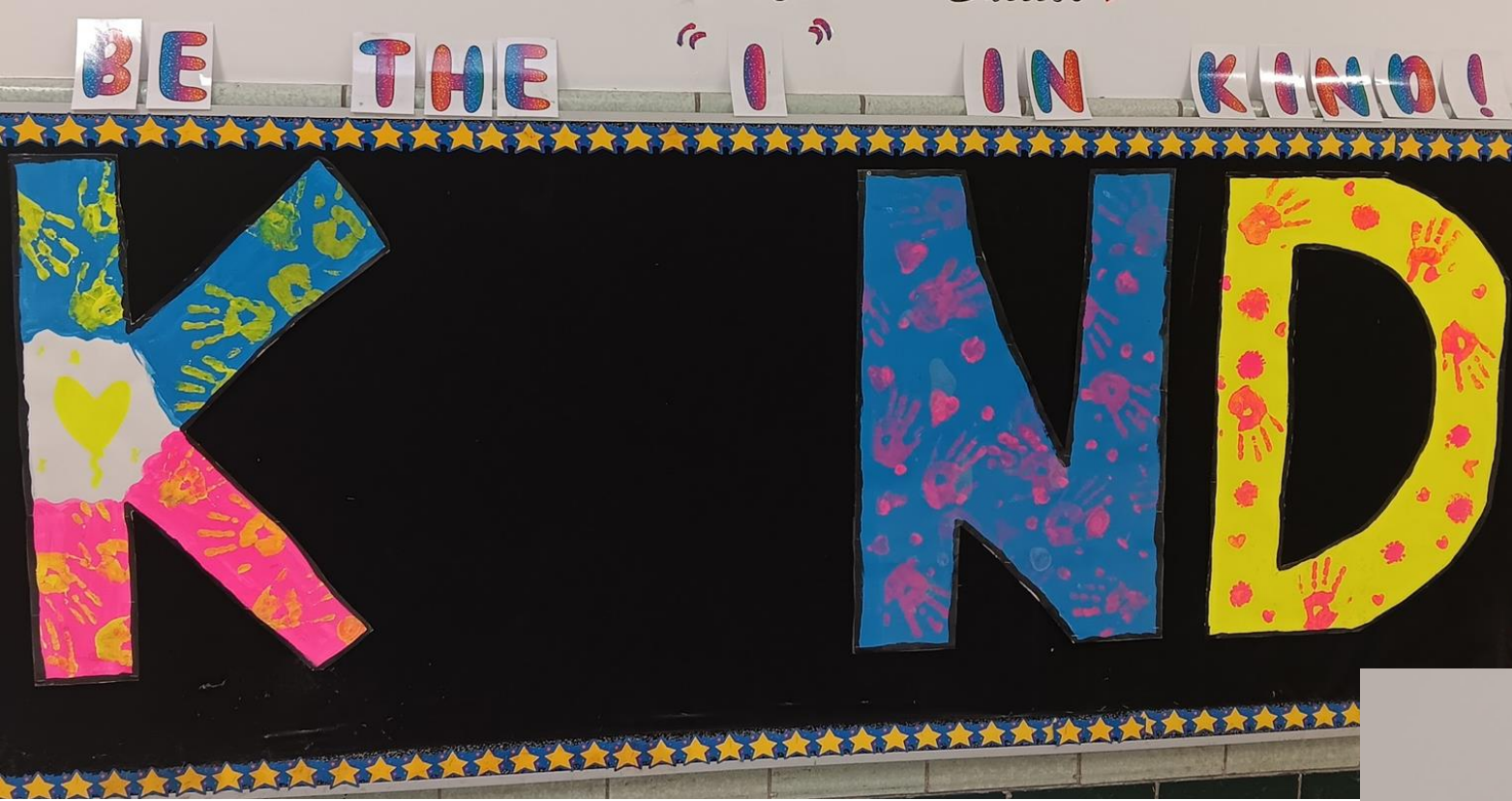

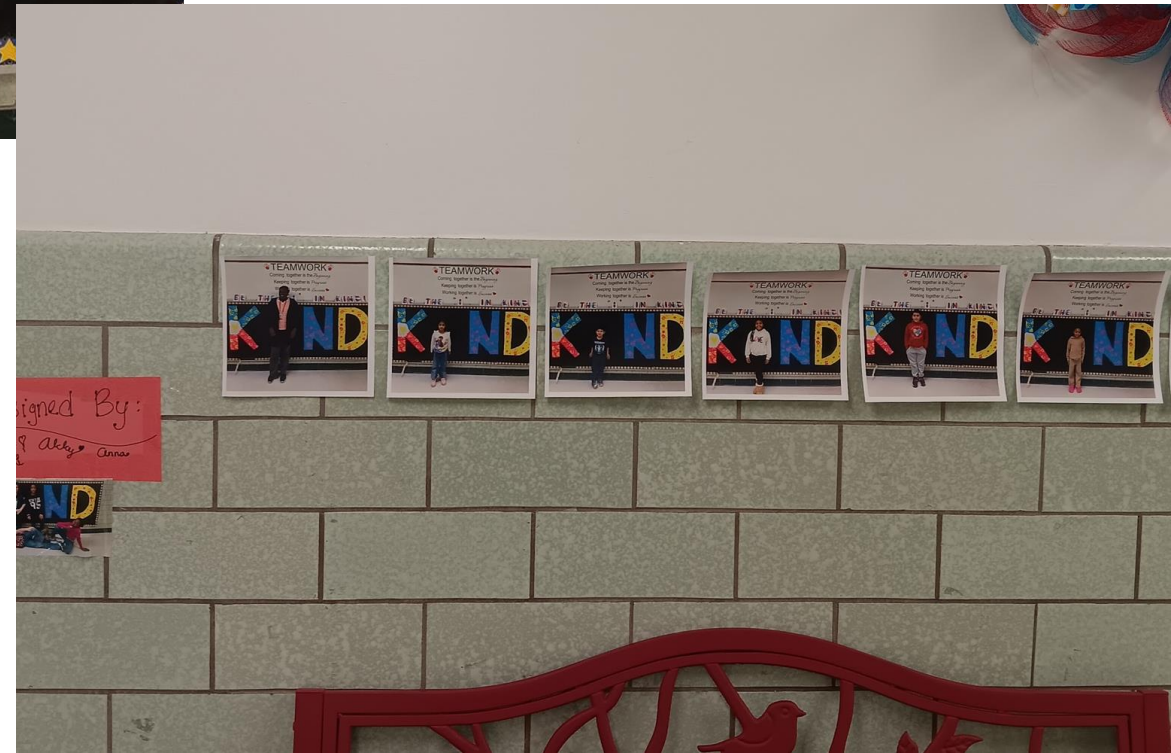


PROGRAMS & ACTIVITIES

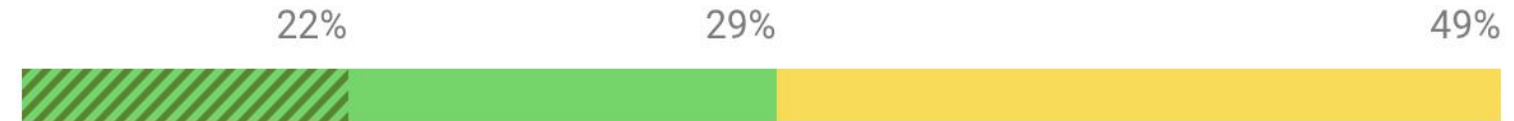

Current Placement Distribution



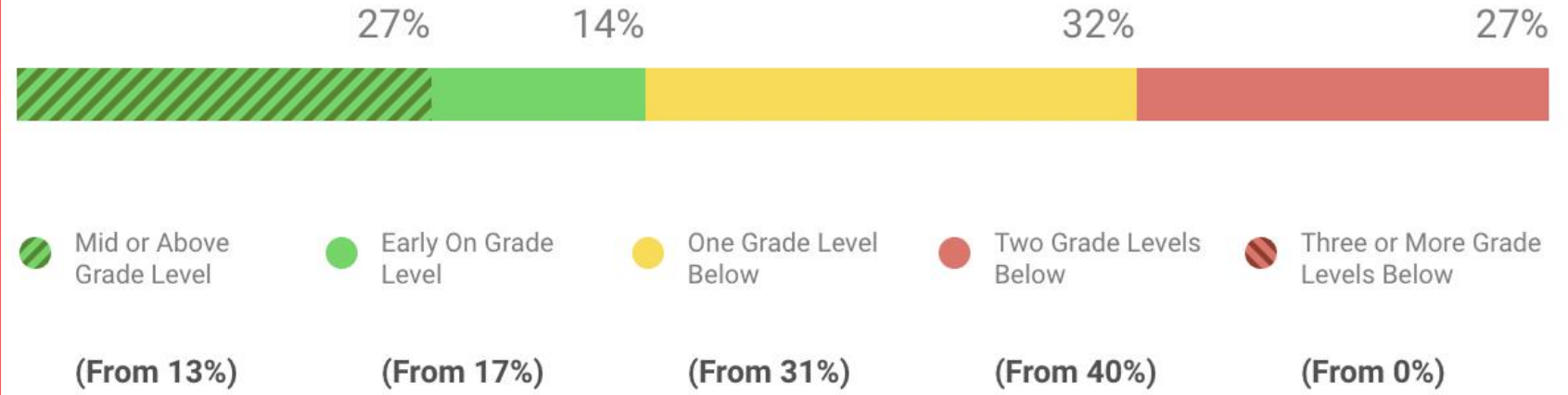

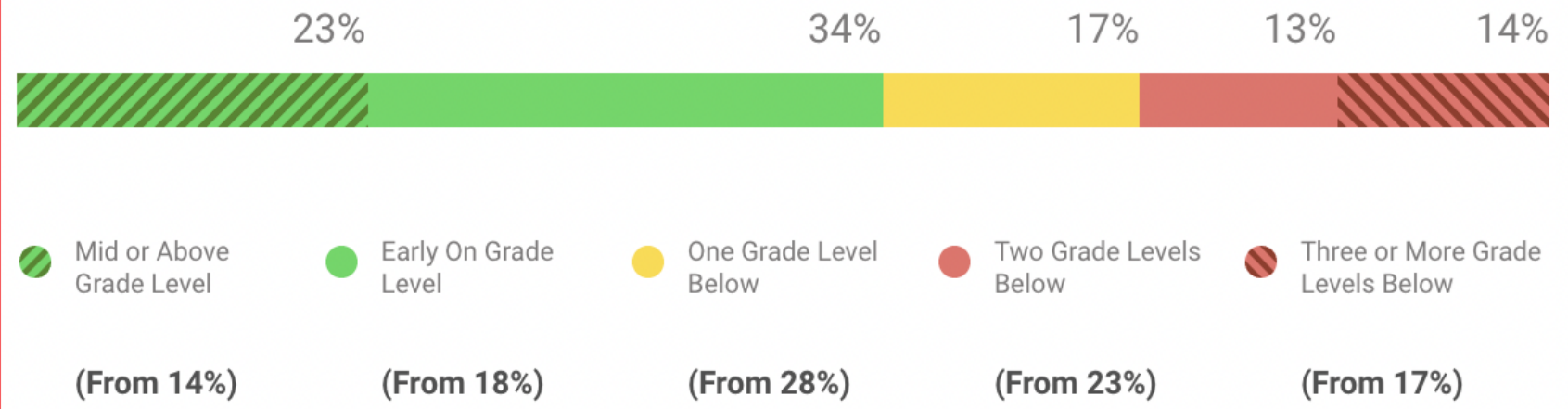

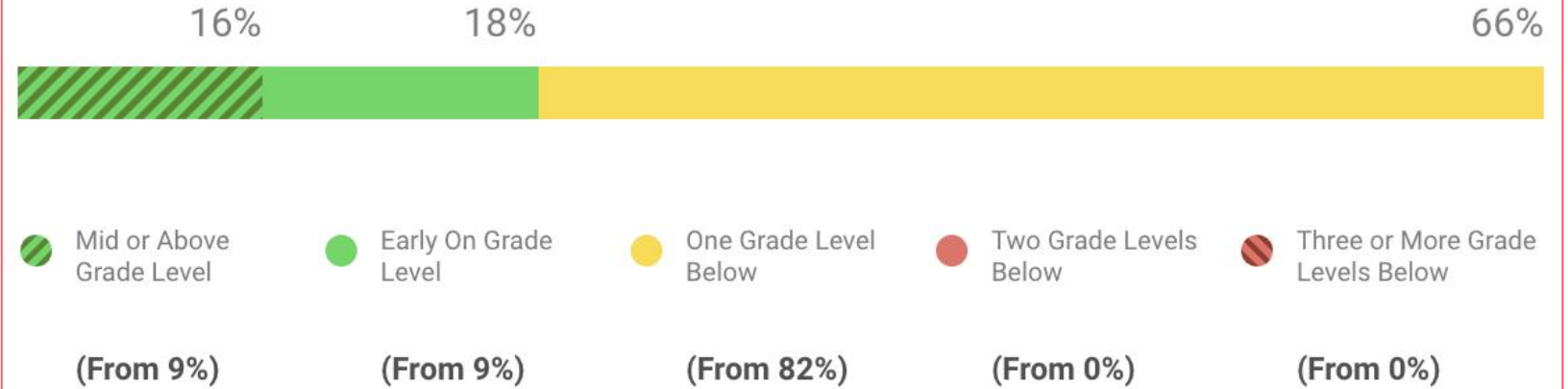

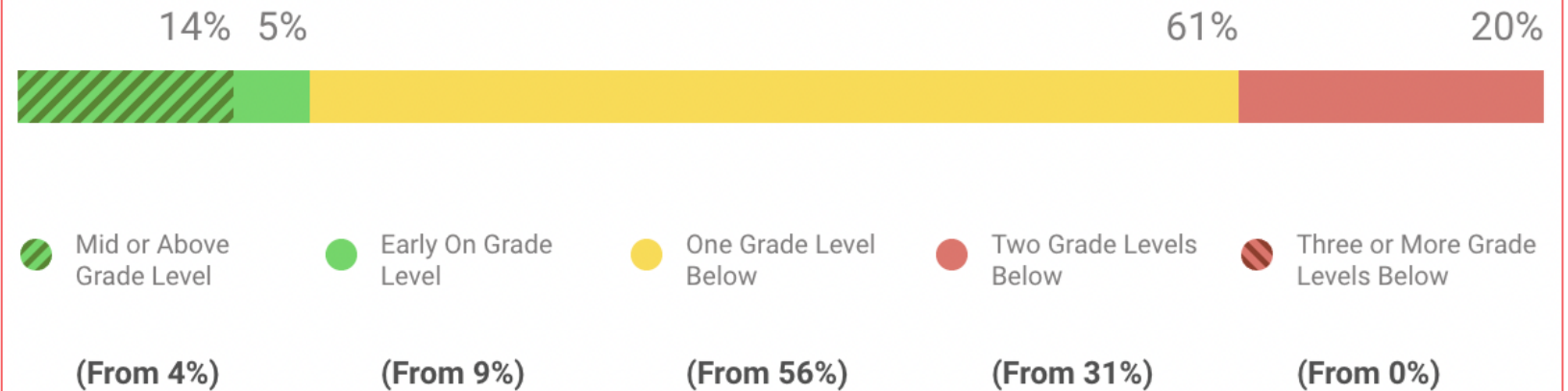

Current Placement Distribution

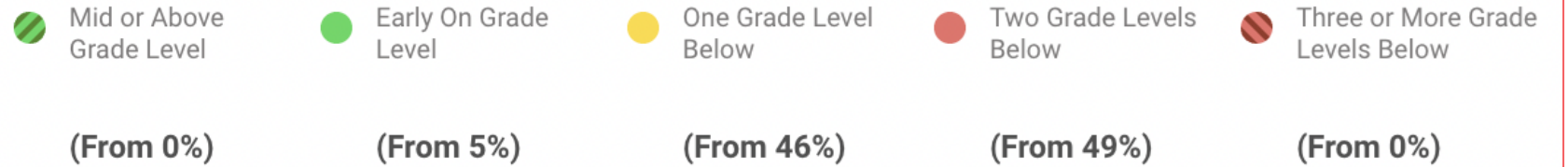

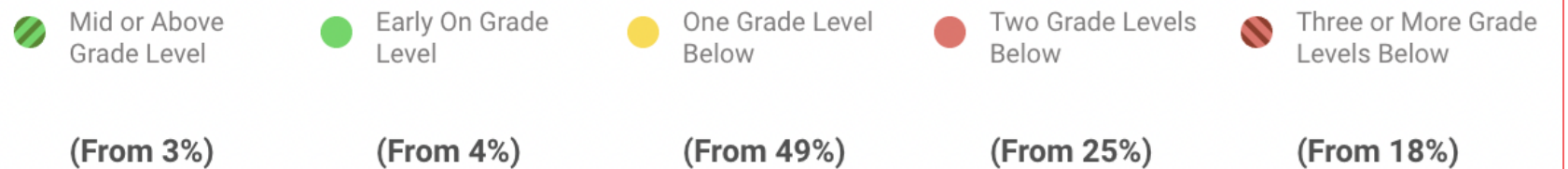

Current Placement Distribution

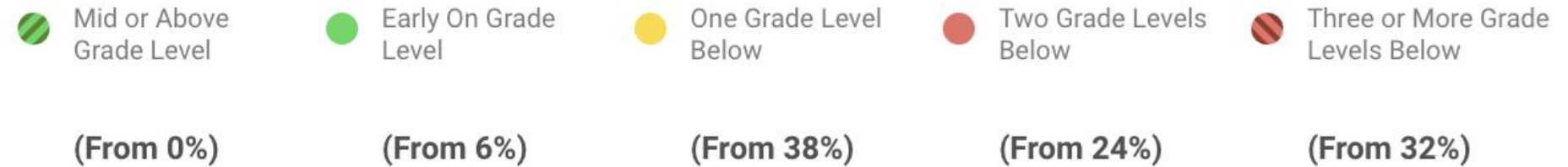
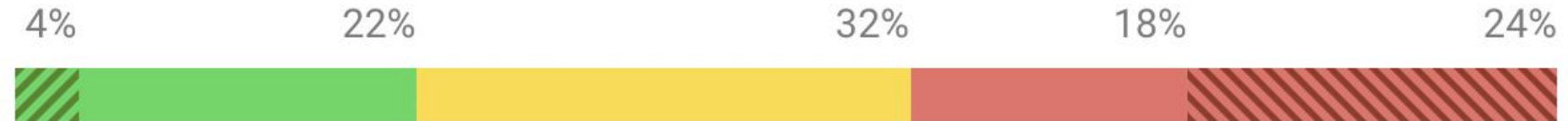

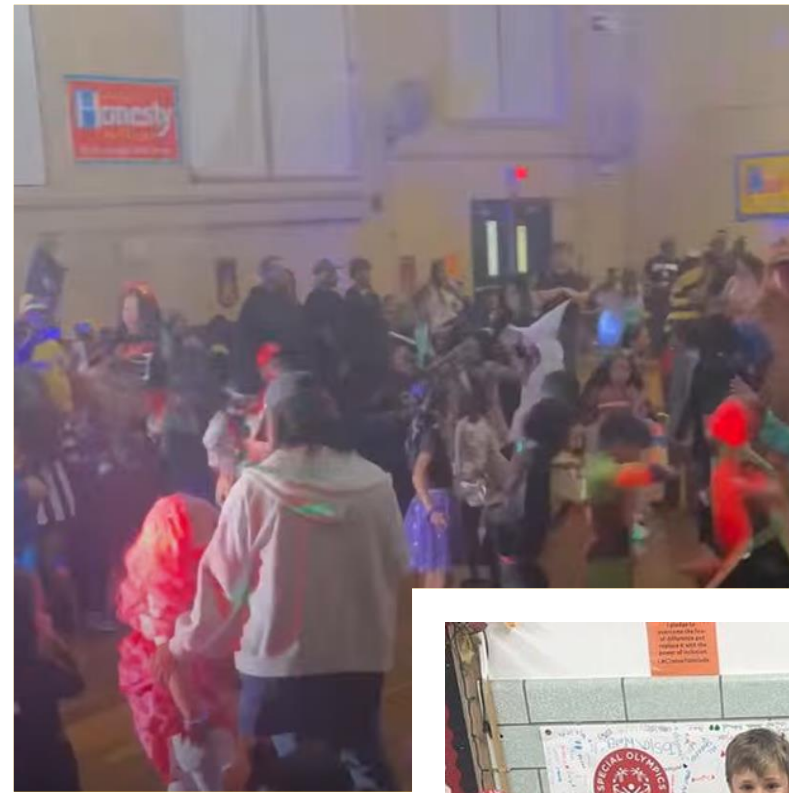
