Thank you for your submission of the revised budget as requested by the Division of Early Childhood Education (DECE). Your 2020-2021 Preschool Program Plan and Budget Statement submission is now approved by the Department.

Please be aware that Preschool Education Aid (PEA) is provided to fund general education students. Districts receiving PEA should account for the full cost of the general education portion of the preschool program in the special revenue fund, Fund 20. The costs to educate self-contained preschool disabled students and the cost of support services needed for preschool disabled students served in general education classrooms should be accounted for in the applicable Special Education cost centers of the General Fund.

The district is responsible for delineating the funding streams and should be prepared to document this division for any audit purposes.
