**Addendum Number One to the Articulation Agreement**

**By and between**

**Kean University and Union High School**

This Addendum Number One (“Addendum”) amends the existing agreement entered into by and between Union High School, located at 2350 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Union, New Jersey (“School”) and Kean University, with an address of 1000 Morris Avenue, Union, NJ 07083 (“Kean”) on the date of November 1, 2023 (“Agreement”).

This Addendum’s effective date is May 1, 2026.

WHEREAS, Kean and School have an Agreement valid till January 31, 2028; and

WHEREAS, the parties agree to further amend the Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants and mutual promises herein contained, Kean and School agree as follows:

1. School has reviewed the updated dual enrollment rates introduced by Kean on April 29, 2026. Pursuant to the updates the attached Exhibit A and Addendum 1 herein replace Exhibit A, and Addendum I of the Agreement.
2. Except as set forth in this Addendum, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement between Kean University and School shall remain in full force and effect, unmodified.

## EXHIBIT A

### PARTNERSHIP OPTION SHEET

The Kean Board of Trustees has approved the following options for the 2026-2027 academic year (*Note: the University may amend these options from time to time*).

#### OPTION 1

Kean curriculum taught by Kean faculty/instructor

- Curriculum tuition is \$215 per credit.
- Students registering for a course must hold a GPA of 3.0 or better\*\*.
- Maximum of 15 credits per student for the year.
- Intent of minimum of 15 students registered in a year.
- Final grade must be C+ or higher for transfer to Kean (*subject to change per specific program requirements*).

#### OPTION 2

Kean curriculum taught by a high school teacher at the School District\*.

- Curriculum tuition is \$133 per credit.
- Students registering for a course must hold a GPA of 3.0 or better\*\*.
- High school teacher must be approved by Kean to teach Kean curriculum.
- Kean must be allowed to assess curriculum instruction.
- Kean may evaluate student performance through tests/assignments.
- Final grade must be C+ or higher for transfer to Kean (*subject to change per specific program requirements*).

#### OPTION 3

Curriculum Mapping

- One-time administrative charge of \$80 per student.
- School District and Kean admissions shall map approved curriculum.
- School District Instructor shall teach approved curriculum.
- Kean shall administer a final test/assessment.
- Kean shall grade curriculum as pass/fail.
- Student can transfer curriculum for credit upon enrollment to Kean.

NOTE: The parties shall evaluate the articulation agreement upon the completion of a 2-year term from the execution date.

*\*Program exceptions and approvals apply*

*\*\*Exceptions can be made on case-by-case basis*
