As godson of renaissance man Paul Robeson, Joshua Paul Thompson grew up with inspiration all around him. His parents Ernest and Maggie were active in the civil rights movement and his sister Mindy exposed him to a full spectrum of music at an early age. From The Temptations to Jimi Hendrix, The Doors to Leadbelly, Smokey Robinson to Leonard Bernstein he was unknowingly training his ear to write in any style.

By 16 years old, he led his own group to Germany to perform at The World Youth Festival. As a Rutgers University college student, he studied with and was mentored by the world renowned "Jazz Professors" including the late great Frank Foster and keyboard legend Kenny Barron. Josh went on to win an award from The National Endowment for the Arts and soon started a small production company with friend, producer and mentor Gene Lennon.

In a few short months, they were signed as writers to Universal/MCA records with they're biggest song becoming the title cut of the Grammy nominated album "What You See is What You Sweat" by Aretha Franklin.

Josh went on to write 19 hit singles including co-writing the groundbreaking "All the Things Your Man Won't Do" with artist and friend Joe Thomas.

Joshua Paul has over 100 songs released that have helped propel the sales of over 33 million records! He is the recipient of ASCAP's coveted "Top 10" award, multiple Grammy participation awards and has been honored by ASCAP as one of *New York's 50 Best Writers*.
