The New Jersey School Boards Association Insurance Group (NJSBAIG) recognizes that in this current climate of tightening school budgets it has become increasingly more difficult to spend money on safety. In an effort to help alleviate this problem; NJSBAIG has established a Safety Grant Program which will award, in 2012, a total of \$4,000,000 to our member New Jersey public school districts. The Safety Grant Program is designed to help members make safety, security and educational related purchases toward loss prevention at the individual district level which ultimately affects the health of the overall ERIC NORTH sub fund.

A Grant Committee, of ERIC NORTH representatives, has been organized and has developed the guidelines for which a Safety Grant may be applied for. Your district's individual available grant allotment is: \$36,304.00. To have your application considered for a safety grant award the following criteria must be met;

- Application must apply to Building and Plant Safety, Building Security, Safety Equipment and/or Professional Development and Training.
- Application must be submitted by April 1, 2012.
- District must be a member of the ERIC North Sub fund from July 1, 2012 to June 30, 2013.
- A signed board resolution (attached) for grant application must be returned with your application.

The application review process will be handled by the ERIC NORTH GRANT COMMITTEE with overall acceptance by the membership of the ERIC NORTH. An acceptance letter acknowledging receipt of your grant application with any clarifying questions, if applicable, will be sent in May 2012. Approval of the grant will be awarded in July 2012. Check distribution will take place at the September 2012 ERIC NORTH meeting.

The mission of the NJSBAIG, a non profit school insurance pool, is to provide the availability of insurance to the New Jersey school districts by offering the best coverage at the lowest possible cost, by providing insurance education and risk management services. Having the Safety Grant Program assists NJSBAIG in accomplishing its mission.

The safety grant program is a method of returning some underwriting surplus to NJSBAIG members. It is designed to help members make safety, security and educational related purchases.

Total sub fund safety grant amounts allocated to each sub fund member will be forwarded to the NJSBAIG Comptroller (by sub fund) for review and verification to the total sub fund allotted amounts PRIOR TO any distribution of this data to the sub fund member districts and/or any of the following steps in these procedures.

Each member will be informed of the safety grant amount available to them. The NJSBAIG actuary will determine the amount available to each sub fund. Each sub fund will allocate the total amount defined by the actuary to each member of the sub fund.

Non sub fund members will be offered the opportunity to apply for safety grants as defined by the NJSBAIG actuary.

Applications accompanied by an official letter outlining the specific amount of each district's proposed grant allotment will be sent out each year a safety grant will be awarded. The 2012 Safety Grant Applications will be distributed in **December/January of 2012**. Sub fund members will receive this application, explanation of the application process and grant available amount via correspondence from each fund administrator. Non sub fund members will receive correspondence directly from NJSBAIG via the Member Services department.

The grant application must be returned for review by **April 1, 2012**. The sub funds will have a grant committee review the applications and judge their appropriateness. The NJSBAIG Director or his designate will do the same for the non sub fund group.

Members will be notified via letter that their application has been accepted and the grant committees will meet in May 2012. Notification of the actual approval will take place in July 2012 and check issuance will be set for September 2012.

Checks for sub fund members will be distributed during their respective **September/October** sub fund meetings. Non sub fund members will have their checks awarded during a member services visitation during the months of **September/October**.

District must renew coverage the year the grant is applied for and be a member in good standing to receive the grant funding. Off 7/1 renewals will follow the same process as above.

We will encourage board meeting reenactment of the check presentation for all sub fund and non subfund members.

Unapplied grant monies will be returned to the specific sub fund (or in the case of non sub fund accounts to NJSBAIG) for reallocation to members in the following year.

Each year the Safety Grant Process and allocation will be defined by the Director/Trustees.

Sidewalk repairs, Playground surfacing, Stair treads and Lunch tables

**Building security including:** 

Security cameras and systems (including upgrades), Access entry, Visitor management systems, Exterior lighting, Walkie talkies integrated with police communications and Door locking systems

Safety equipment and training:

School bus radios integrated with police communications, School bus camera systems, Emergency response equipment (i.e. bullhorns), AEDs, Scissor lifts, Confined space equipment (i.e. respirators), Slip resistant shoes, Step ladders or Step stools and Personal Protective Equipment
