AV Master Technicians**:

The Master Technician is responsible for overseeing the operation, installation, hang and focus of all theatrical equipment used for any event presented in a district theatrical venue. They must have significant background and training in regards to safety and proper use of theatrical equipment. Also must serve to instruct interested students in the proper use and safety associated with effectively using the equipment. They receive a rate of \$20.00/hour, not to exceed 200 hours per semester.

AV Assistant Technicians**:

The Assistant Technician is responsible for assisting in the set up and operation of all theatrical equipment used for any event presented in a district theatrical venue. They receive a rate of \$10.00/hour, not to exceed 200 hours per semester.
