Recently one of our teachers passed away after a yearlong battle against cancer. During that struggle, Jack DeBarbieri became a symbol of perseverance and courage. His personal strength and determination was witnessed by all of our students as he courageously fought for over a year while still coming to work and completing his duties as a Health and Physical Education instructor.

Jack began his career at Kawameeh Junior High School in 1974 after graduating from Montclair State College with a degree in Health and Physical Education. For 44 years he fulfilled his duties under five principals and several supervisors and superintendents. For many years he coached wrestling at Kawameeh and Union High School. He was also an assistant football coach at Union High School during the Lou Rettino Era. He was one of the first coaches who volunteered time in the Recreational Wrestling Program begun in the 1980's. He truly has had a positive impact on thousands of Union students.

For those reasons, I would like the memory of Jack DeBarbieri to remain alive here at Kawameeh for many years by placing a plaque at the entrance to the gym memorializing his service to our school, our community, and our children. Enclosed please find a copy of an original letter sent at an earlier date for your consideration. Since it did not deal with urgent business, it was probably tabled for a future meeting, but now, as the school year is shortening, it has become a bit more urgent.

In another letter submitted on March 1, 2019, I submitted my notification of retirement as of July 1, 2019. These two letters, therefore, are linked, in that I wanted to leave the Little Library as a farewell gift to Washington School upon my departure.

I ask that this matter be addressed at the next possible meeting so that I know whether or not to proceed with a purchase. Details about style, location, and installation would have to be resolved rather quickly if approval is given.

I love books! I have also loved my years of teaching in Union, particularly at Washington School, my "home away from home" for quite some time. I would, therefore, like to endow this school with a gift of a LITTLE LIBRARY BOOK EXCHANGE.

Basically, these libraries are small, free-standing structures that hold a limited amount of books. The premise is that a reader selects a book to read and then returns it or replaces it with another book. The library is open to the reading community and operates on the "take a book, give a book" honor system. A print-out of a prototype is enclosed with this proposal.

I would cover the cost of the LITTLE LIBRARY, as this is a gift of gratitude from me and my family for time well-spent at Washington School. (Our children attended this school upon our arrival as township residents in 1987.) I would also cover the cost of installation by the Township/BOE Maintenance Crew. There are three possibilities with respect to location and installation.

- (1): Since the front lawn of Washington School is quite large, I envision that the LITTLE LIBRARY could be installed there, providing access for both Washington students and members of the surrounding neighborhood. Throughout the years, other structures have been installed on the school grounds that have captured the special memories and little histories of Washington School.
- (2): If a free-standing LITTLE LIBRARY is not possible, perhaps it would be possible to affix the cabinet portion to the actual building, providing access to the books by students and neighbors without the hazards of a free-standing structure.
- (3): If an outdoor installation is not at all feasible, a LITTLE LIBRARY may be installed indoors. There are many other styles available, and some would be more conducive to indoor use. Another print out shows a second possible prototype. Again, I would cover the costs of purchase and installation.

I do not want this gift to in any way be attributed to me- no signs or plaques. I simply want to "pay forward" some of the joy that I have received from both reading and teaching.

Thank you for your consideration in this matter. I look forward to your reply.



This neighbrohood library features a plexiglass door and plexiglass side walls. This design makes it easy to spot the books inside. Also featured is an asphalt roof with a built in solar light. The light will come on at dusk and turn off at dawn. The light has a solar cell on the roof that recharges the batteries during the day. I make all my little libraries from Cedar with a plywood roof for added durability. Your library will arrive with the finish level you choose, Sanded and ready for you to complete the finish, primed, or fully stained and varnished. The window is made with shatter resistant plexi glass for added safety. -The book area is approximately 14 1/2" wide and 10" deep and 19" tall. -The opening at the door is approx 11" x 14". -A adjustable and removable shelf is Installed inside to allow you to customize the library to fit your books. Your library will arrive with all the brackets and screws required to mount it to a 4x4 post. The 4x4 post is not included, since they would double the shipping price. A post can normally be purchased locally for less than \$10. You will need a screwdriver and a small bottle of exterior wood glue to complete the installation.
