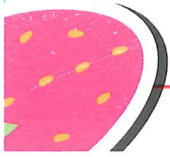
Girls In Gear Program

UHS Dance Team

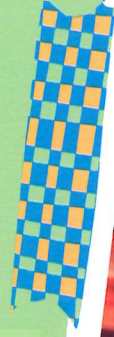
- Participated in competition and scored elite gold in both categories
