RE: Travel to Paris, France - Summer of 2014

DAY 2: PARIŞ


- Meet your Prométour Tour Director at Charles de Gaulle Airport in Paris.

DAY 4: VERSAILLES / PARIS


- Breakfast at your hotel.

- Admire the view of the city from the 3rd floor of the Eiffel Tower.

- Next, discover the Fragonard perfume museum, which opened in 1983, occupies a very lovely Napoleon III town house built in 1860 by Lesoufaché, a student of Garnier. The decoration is entirely of that period. Here you can discover a wonderful collection of perfumery objects that take you travelling through the ages.
- Enjoy some free time for lunch in the area. Perhaps do a little last minute shopping at Galeries Lafayette.
- Some last minute shopping on rue Rivoli.
- This afternoon, visit the Hôtel des Invalides, founded by Louis XIV to shelter 7,000 aged or crippled former soldiers.
- Dinner and overnight in Paris.
