The Union Police Department has been asked to make recommendations to improve Traffic Flow and Pedestrian Safety at Hannah Caldwell School. The Police Department has studied the area and after consulting with the school Principle Mrs. DiGiovanni and Board of Education attorney Jim Domato, we have identified the following existing conditions as well as areas for potential improvement.

Current Traffic

- Ingress and egress is permitted from both the Commerce Driveway and the Hendricks Driveway.
- Traffic is NOT permitted to use the "ONE WAY Circulation loop."
- All traffic is redirected to the travel/parking aisles.
- Traffic congestion/gridlock is present during peak AM/PM times.
- Non School related Through Traffic is routinely observed using the school property at all hours
 of the day and evening. This includes the Lincoln Technical School students and Hickory Manor
 Residents, and DPW employees and equipment.
- Parking is prohibited on both sides of Hendricks Drive behind the school at AM/PM peak times.
 This was originally requested to enhance safety and facilitate better traffic flow on Hendricks Drive.
- Parents routinely ignore the posted regulations and park illegally on both sides of Hendricks Drive.
- Commerce Ave (school side) is currently posted as a NO PARKING ZONE.
- Commerce Ave (across from school) was recently changed to 2 hr time limit to curtail commuter and all day staff/faculty parking.

Recommendations

Adopt the original "Conceptual Circulation Improvement Plan" as proposed by T&M Associates with a ONE WAY modification for Hendricks Drive.

Implement a" locked gate policy" at gate onto Hendricks Drive at all time except AM/PM peaks.
 This will eliminate DPW bound and other through traffic. The chain should have a Police/Fire

Knox Lock in addition to a school pad lock. The gate should be secured in the open position prior to and during snowfalls to allow for proper snow removing and salting.

- Change Hendricks Drive between Main School lot driveway and the Deron School round-a-bout from a two way street to a ONE WAY street heading south.
- Change existing parking ordinance to allow on-street parking of school buses to load and unload
 at the rear of the school. Restrict parking on the western side of Hendricks. (To prevent children
 from crossing in between the stopped school buses)
- Allow parents to use the drop off loop for curbside lane drop offs during AM/PM peaks.
 Maintain One-way flow in main lot travel lane adjacent to handicapped parking spaces (as depicted on plan)
- Encourage traffic to exit on Hendricks Drive towards Vauxhall Rd.
- Designate new SCHOOL BUS LOADING/UNLOADING area curbside on Hendricks adjacent to existing metal building.
- Township will adopt ordinance changes for Hendricks Drive and post appropriate signage prohibiting two way traffic on Hendricks drive beyond the Deron School round-a-bout.
- A diagram depicting the Revised Traffic Circulation Plan and Parent instruction sheet will be designed for distribution to parents, staff and faculty.

The Union Police is seeking the Board of Education's continued input and concurrence with the proposed recommendations

Upon approval, the Township would need approximately 60 days lead time to process the Hendricks Drive ordinance change and post appropriate signage


