I further certify that I have examined said list and the rules as well as the supplemental eligibility guidelines adopted by the NJSIAA prior to making this affidavit and I am satisfied and certify that the facts stated herein are true.

In addition I am aware that as a member I, or my designee, must maintain our membership in good standing as the second criterion of eligibility for teams and/or individuals to apply for participation in NJSIAA sponsored tournaments/championships.

To maintain "Membership in Good Standing: the following conditions must be met by **October 1, 2016**:

1. Payment of Annual Membership Dues
2. The Principal's Affidavit
3. The Coaches' Affidavit
4. Board Membership Resolution Card

To be eligible for tournaments/championships for the fall season, the following additional requirements must be met by **October 1, 2016**:


1. No outstanding invoices older than 90 days
2. Fall Participation Survey
3. Maintains a Fall Ineligible Athletes list as per Article V, Section 4, of the NJSIAA Constitution

To be eligible for tournaments/championships for the winter season, the following additional requirements must be met by **December 15, 2016**:


1. No outstanding invoices older than 90 days
2. Winter Participation Survey
3. Maintains a Winter Ineligible Athletes list as per Article V, Section 4, of the NJSIAA Constitution

To be eligible for tournaments/championships for the Spring Season, the following additional requirements must be met by **March 15, 2017**:

1. No outstanding invoices older than 90 days.
2. Spring Participation Survey
3. Maintains a Spring Ineligible Athletes list as per Article V, Section 4, of the NJSIAA Constitution

**MEMBERSHIP RESOLUTION

State of New Jersey, as provided for in Chapter 172 Laws 1979 (N.J.S.A. 18A:11-3, et seq.)

herewith enrolls Union High School

This resolution to continue to effect until or unless rescinded by the Board of Education and shall be included among those policies adopted annually by the Board. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:11-3 in adopting this resolution, the Board of Education adopts as its own policy and agrees to be governed by the Constitution Bylaws and Rules and Regulations of the NJSIAA.

A photocopy of the minutes signifying the adoption of this membership resolution is attached.

Administrative Responsibility—The Association must rely upon the voluntary compliance by its member schools in enforcing the eligibility standards set forth in Bylaws, Article V. Toward that end, the Principal in each member school has the affirmative obligation to report to the NJSIAA any violations of these standards. The fact that a school has disclosed that there has been an eligibility violation will not relieve the affected school of sanctions that may be imposed against it, pursuant to Article X of the Bylaws, including the forfeiture of games or events. However, the failure to disclose an eligibility violation may be grounds for imposing additional sanctions upon the offending school.

In addition, a school must maintain a status of "Member in Good Standing" as outlined in the Principal's Affidavit to remain eligible for NJSIAA activities and tournaments.
