Purpose:

The purpose of this event is to educate and bring awareness to our community regarding the topic of Juneteenth and its effect on Black history and modern culture. This event is also designed to provide a platform of unity and understanding across the African diaspora as well as multiple racial and cultural backgrounds in the community.

Modified Plan

This plan will be a condensed version of the three day event suggested in the previous proposal while implementing new ideas and strategies. The new plan would consist of a two day event starting on Friday June 18th and ending on Saturday June 19th.

Location Options:

- -Football Field
- -Main Parking
- -Side Field
- -Big/Small Gym

Day 1: Showcase

Date: Friday June 18th, 2021 (RAIN DATE JUNE 19th or 25th)

Roots: Black Excellence club will lead a showcase event that'll not only educate but involve various leaders in the community. The showcase will include spoken word, music, art displays, dances, songs, a panel and more interactive performances. We also plan to include snack booths from sponsored local businesses as well as ways to include elementary school students! We'd also request that chairs from UHS would be placed in the showcase area. (Chairs used during graduation)

WITH THE GOVERNOR'S ANNOUNCEMENT INTENDING TO RELAX THE RESTRICTIONS ON INDOOR EVENTS, THE REQUESTED LOCATION IS THE UHS AUDITORIUM AS ORIGINALLY PROPOSED.

To include the younger generation, we'd have them help draw a chalk path outside the event. Leaders from Roots: Black Excellence would split up into small groups with the kids to help them draw out a colorful path. This path would lead up to the entrance of the event at the field and would picture many different leaders and quotes.

This Showcase event would take place on the UHS field near the track. The program would run from around 6:00-8:30 pm. There would be plenty of activities for people to enjoy their time.

Day 2: Jubilation Day/Movie Night

Date: Saturday June 19th, 2021 (RAIN DATE JUNE 20TH OR 26TH)

The Roots: Black Excellence Club will combine with the Social Justice Committee of Union in a Day of play/Movie Night at the UHS Field. Food trucks, games and activities will be at the field while a movie will screen during the evening. (We hope to include activities that are for grade and middle school aged students as well). This event would be a day long event and people could come in throughout the day. Refreshments will also be sold during the event.

Covid-19 Planning:

We are well aware of the issues the pandemic can pose. To ensure that safety and caution are prioritized we have chosen to implement multiple strategies to secure the safety of the community.

-Ticket Sales/Covid-Forms: All ticket/ concession sales will be administered virtually. In order to participate in the events, possible attendants must fill out a covid questionnaire form (that will be sent towards or on the date of the event) to evaluate for symptoms. (These event admission forms must be filled out with proper identification to ensure that this process runs smoothly). On the day of the event tickets must be presented (printed or via cell phone) to verify admission. (A list of names of attendees who have filled out the Covid Forms and paid for their ticket will be available for further confirmation.)

-Temperature Checks: For all in person events, verified attendees will have their temperatures checked via touchless forehead thermometers. (This procedure will be administered by Roots Advisors or Community Volunteers who have been temperature checked themselves) Any attendees who have a temperature corresponding to that of a fever will be sent home immediately and refunded their ticket fee.

-Social Distancing: For all in person events, attendees and audience members will either be spaced out 6-8 feet apart in designated seating booths (which will be sanitised prior) or within/near their cars at distanced parking.

-Sanitation: All Roots members, planning committees, performers, volunteers, advisors, and audience members will be required to wear a face mask covering their noses throughout the events and are constantly advised to remain distanced. (Designated ushers will make sure of this). There is a possibility that gloves will be administered to the audience/attendees as well.) Upon arrival, hand sanitiser will also be administered. In regards to possible concessions, all food will be prepared and securely packaged prior and will be distributed carefully to each attending in their designated seating area or near their car, thus reducing contamination. (Any member/volunteer who deals with meal prep will be required

to wear face masks/shields and gloves). Ushers will monitor whether individuals disregard these guidelines and will advise people to stay distanced and to clean up around themselves.

With BOTH events, social distance guidelines will be followed. Masks will be required as well as proper temperature checks. We'd request the highschool small gym for appropriate covid checks and activities if necessary.

Summation: As stated earlier in this proposal, the intent behind these possible events and guidelines is to fallicate strength, unity, and understanding within the community. We acknowledge the severity of the current pandemic and have taken these possible obstacles and issues into great consideration. Especially in these challenging and polarizing times, we see this as an opportunity to spread knowledge, awareness, support and open mindedness, which is needed now more than ever.
