

A working definition, according to the National Research Center (2010), describes computational thinking as the reformulation of seemingly difficult problems into something a human can know how to solve by drawing on concepts fundamental to computer science. Computational thinking is increasingly considered to be a fundamental skill at the core of all STEM disciplines and “intrinsic to all other disciplines” (Henderson et. al., 2007).

STEM disciplines are becoming increasingly in demand as technology expands and grows. Many states and countries are increasing funding and investing in robotics programs and clubs in order to compete in the global marketplace and increase the number of young people pursuing careers in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics. Studies show that robotics can generate a high degree of student interest and engagement in math and science careers (Miller & Stein, 2000; Welch & Huffman, 2011).
