

Course Description

Students in TV Production 3 will learn to develop a news show while continuing to develop their skills in both field production and studio production. Students will learn new skills focusing in news broadcasting, where they will learn to develop, film and edit their own news package stories to air on long format news show days, as well as for Township of Union Channel 34/36. News packages will be produced for school and community events, and students will develop original story ideas. Students will continue to advance their writing techniques for TV news and practicing the rules of writing for the ear. Students will be considered as the "Level One News Team" and will work behind the scenes of the morning news show to help the TV Production IV student crew members (Level Two News Team) develop the show by writing the scripts for the news show.
