About the \$10k donation opportunity:

AdoptaClassroom.org is a national non-profit with a mission to help fund teachers with financial resources to purchase the supplies needed for their classroom and students (without spending their own money). We are celebrating our 21st year and are headquartered in Minneapolis, Minnesota. Since our non-profit was founded, we have disbursed more than \$30 million dollars to teachers in schools across our country.

One of our national sponsors is Burlington Stores (formerly known as Burlington Coat Factory). They will be opening a store on Sept. 27th at the shops at West Branch Commons located at 1701 Morris Avenue, Union, NJ 07083.

In celebration of Burlington's new store we would like to donate \$10k to one of the district's elementary schools. The money is to be divided equally among the school's classroom teachers so they are able to purchase supplies based on needs for their individual classrooms.

Ideally, Burlington would like to surprise the teachers and present the check at one of the schools regularly scheduled assemblies or school gatherings some time around 9/16-9/20 (though I know that's the first week of school, and therefore we can be flexible)- in order to align with the store's recent grand opening.

#### The general criteria for the school selection is;

- 1. Elementary level school
- 2. Preferably a higher-need, Title 1 school
- 3. Within close proximity to the new Burlington store (West Branch Commons) within approx. 5 miles would be great.
- 4. The school/principal is willing to have Burlington store manager come to their school to present the check (and allow for local media to be invited to cover the presentation)

It is our policy that the **funding is to be disbursed through AdoptAClassroom.org**- merely as a way to ensure the funds are being put back into the classrooms. Following the donation, each teacher will create a virtual savings account through our website where they can use the funds to purchase supplies for their classroom. We are partnered with a wide range of 30+ vendors including Office Depot, Best Buy, Scholastic, etc. I will also note that on a case-by-case instance, we can allow out-of-network purchases for any items that are not offered through our vendors, everything from technology to field trip expenses are allowed. We will work with the school principal closer to the event date to make sure all teachers are registered to receive funds.

As briefly mentioned above, we'd love for the district/school to **share the news and invite local media** to be a part of the donation event/check presentation.

That is quite a lot of info I just provided. So, for next steps:

- · elementary school selection who will be receiving the funding
- the main contact for organizing details (whether that's yourself, the school principal, or someone else)
- 2-3 preferred dates/times available weeks of 8/26-8/30 following to schedule a call between all involved parties (myself Burlington school principal yourself communications officer)

\*\*Of course we've just begun conversations, and I'd love to hop on the phone with you prior to moving into the next steps.
