## 5513 CARE OF SCHOOL PROPERTY

The Board of Education believes that the schools district should help students learn to respect property and instill to develop feelings of pride in their school emmunity institutions. The Board requires charges each student enrolled in the this district to responsibly with responsibility for the proper care for of school property and the school supplies and equipment entrusted to the student his/her use by the school district.

Students who cause damage to **or lose** school property **may** will be subject to disciplinary measures. The Board authorizes the imposition of a fine for the loss, damage, or **destruction** defacement of a textbook and reserves the right to withhold a report card or diploma from any student whose payment of a fine is in arrears.

School property includes but is not limited to any district issued technology devices (i.e. computers, Chromebook, etc.) Please reference district policy 7523-School District Provided Technology Devices to Students and the Student Technology Acceptable Use of Agreement.

A student who demonstrates chronic and/or serious disregard for property may be referred to the Child Study Team.

The Superintendent shall develop rules for the safekeeping and accounting of textbooks and prepare a schedule of fines for lost, and damaged, and destroyed textbooks.
